### DOCTORAL PROGRAM IN POLITICAL SCIENCE, PUBLIC POLICY TRACK

The **Public Policy track** is a specialization in the **Ph.D Program** offered by the **Doctoral School of Political Science, Public Policy, and International Relations**, at Central European University (CEU).<sup>1</sup> CEU is an **English language graduate institution** located in Budapest, and **accredited** in both the **United-States** and **Hungary**. The Program is one of the largest, most international and most competitive in Europe. It prepares graduate students for careers in research or higher education institutions.

Satisfactory completion of all Doctoral Program requirements results in the awarding of a **US accredited Doctoral Degree in Political Science**.

#### The Program

The program offers a solid, comprehensive, and methodologically rigorous curriculum in political science. Core courses focus on the development of research skills, analytical abilities and substantive knowledge in the fields of European, international and comparative public policy, governance, and political economy.

Faculty of the Department of Public Policy contributes actively to the Public Policy track teaching and supervision. The multi-disciplinary and multinational faculty team brings a unique set of skills and expertise to the program. In addition to being authoritative voices in their respective fields of research, they have extensive experience in think tanks, national administrations, international organizations, businesses and NGOs. CEU doctoral candidates are actively introduced to research networks in their field through participation in international conferences, major research projects, and the activities of CEU's various research centers and groups.

#### Selected Areas of Research in Public Policy

The multi-disciplinary nature of public policy and the Department's mission to bridge policy and practice are reflected in the faculty's research and teaching interests, which cover: • Public administration, bureaucratic politics and policy learning • Policy reform • Regulation • Public law • European integration and EU public policy • Comparative European politics • International political economy • Global governance • International trade and development • Civil society • Minorities • Delivery of public services and utilities (particularly media and communications, energy and higher education) • Economic, social and labor market policies • Etc.

#### Financial support

CEU offers a number of three-year Full Doctoral Fellowships (including tuition, medical insurance and a monthly stipend) to admitted students. Numerous additional funding opportunities exist, such as the Doctoral Research Support Grant Program, the Erasmus Mobility Scheme, and various research and travel funds
