CU JINONICE CAMPUS

FHS is based in the CU building in the Jinonice District of Prague 5. **Public transport connection**: the Metro line B (yellow), direction to Zličín (from the city centre), go to Nové Butovice metro station, change for BUS 137 or 149 to go to Jinonice station. **Facilities**: PC, Internet, Library; Copy/Print/ Scan self-service, Menza (around 50 CZK/meal), cafeteria. **CU Internet Access**: wired + Wi-Fi (EDUROAM).

CLASSES LOCATIONS

Jinonice campus: **most of the FHS courses** + some of the courses provided by the Faculty of Social Sciences and the Faculty of Arts (Politics, Sociology, International Studies). **Veleslavín** (José Martího 31, Prague 6 – Veleslavín): courses of some FHS MA Departments. **CERGE-EI** (Politických vězňů 7, Prague 1): FHS UPCES courses are held in the building of our partner institution. Fac. of **Social Sciences main building** (Smetanovo nábřeží 6, Prague 1). Fac. of **Arts main building** (náměstí Jana Palacha, Prague 1).

CU DORM ACCOMMODATION

Check-in: passport/ID card, accommodation voucher, a receipt of your deposit payment, one passport size photo. Get the key either at the Accommodation Office or at the non-stop reception (depending on the time of your arrival). You need to **visit the dorm's Accommodation office** during their office hours **to sign** your accommodation contract and **to pay** for the rent for the remaining days in February there. PRAGUE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Single Tickets (valid on all means of public transport with a possibility to change) 24 CZK (valid for 30 min); 32 CZK (90 min); 110 CZK (1 day), 310 CZK (3 days). Available at tickets machines, ticket windows (selected metro stations), or at newsstands. **Must be date-stamped** in order to make them valid (after boarding a bus, tram, or upon entering the metro). **Season Tickets with student discount** (only if you are less than 26 years old) 260 CZK (30-day); 720 CZK (90-day); 1200 CZK (150-day). **Available and valid only with your CU Student Card**. **Full Price Season Tickets** (if you are 26 years old and more) 550 CZK (30-day), 1 480 CZK (90-day), 2 450 CZK (150-day). **Valid with the Prague Transport Card (PIT card)**; **bring one passport size photo**. **Metro and Trams Scheme**: as attached.
