




PRAGUE

TRANSPORTATION

- Carry your isic and transportation card with you at all times
 - The transport. Card grants you free access to all public transport in Prague and most of the outskirts
 - Fines are high and the officers are not always forthcoming and you never know when you'll meet them
- Usually goes on time, there are stops everywhere
- Shared bikes – Rekola, Nextbike (theoretically you should have two 15mins rides for free a day since you paid for the transport. card)
- Shared cars – Anytime, CAR4WAY, hoppygo
- Bolt, Uber, Liftago
- Citizens hate the electric scooters

NEARBY SCHOOL

- Food – bunch of czech pubs, Loving Hut, food court in Stromovka shopping center (running sushi, Korean, fast food, etc.), Happy Noodles
- Parks – Letná, Stromovka
- Caffés – Liberál, Kumbál, Ouky Douky, Kolektor, Vnitroblok, Burza #4
- Galleries – DOX, Veletržní palác National gallery (free entry for students)
- ZOO, Bio Oko, Cross club
- Thrift shops – Kuzmarkt, Textile House; Fashion – Freshlabels, Nila, Kinoko

WHAT TO SEE IN THE CITY I

- Sights – Old Prague, Jewish town, New world (Nový svět)
- Parks – Riegrovy sady (sunsets), Petřín (+ tower), Vyšehrad, Letná
 - Outskirts' parks – Divoká Šárka, Prokopské údolí
- Galleries – Veletržní palác (nearby school), DOX (also nearby school), Gallery Kampa, Rudolfinum
- Museums – National Museum, Jewish Museums, National Technical Museum, Sex Machines Museum



WHAT TO SEE IN THE CITY II

- Theatres – Czech National Theatre, Jatka 78 (summer tent: Azyl 78)
- Classical music + opera – Czech National Theatre, Rudoflinum
 - Last year there was an architecture competition for a new Prague opera building
- Concerts – Rock café, Forum Karlín, Akropolis, Roxy...
- Cinemas – Bio Oko, Světozor, Edison Filmhub, Kino Aero, Kino Pilotů



STUDY FRIENDLY PLACES

- NTK – National Technical Library (free 24/7 entrance, you need an one-use-only for each entrance, or get a card)
- Academy of Sciences, Klementinum, Municipal Library of Prague
- CAFEDU, CAMP
- FHS UK library (ig: @knihovnavkostce)



CAFÉS&CLUBS

- La Boheme Café
- IF Café (IPPA Café)
- Scout institute (Old town square, Kampa), CAMP, Dobrá Trafika, Nona, Nodd, Jericho, Mlýnská
- Tea houses: Andělská čajovna, Dobrá čajovna (no shishas), Kaviár
- Clubs: Vzorkovna (Dog bar), Zázemí, Lucerna, Rock café, Chapeau Rouge



RESTAURANTS&PUBS

- Ambiente restaurants – fancy, good quality, expensive
- Czech cuisine – Lokál, Kuchyň, Kantýna, Louvre
- Manifesto Market
- Vegan – Střecha, Forky's, Moment, Palo Verde
 - Buffets – Loving Hut, Dhaba (vegetarian and vegan! Read description of the meals)

SCAMMERS

- Again: NEVER EXCHANGE MONEY ON THE STREET, always on a counter

CULTURE EVENTS

- Music festivals: United Islands, Metronome festival
- Film festivals: One World, FAMU fest
- Festival of small breweries. 9th – 10th of June 2023
