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General Information

The 4EU+ Alliance connects seven European universities: Charles University, [Heidelberg Universität](#), [Sorbonne Université](#), [Uniwersytet Warszawski](#), [Università degli Studi di Milano](#), [Københavns Universitet](#) and from August 2022 also [Université de Genève](#). Member institutions of 4EU+ Alliance have started their strategic cooperation in 2017. The Alliance was formally founded in 2018 as a general partnership for developing new high-quality cooperation in research, innovations, education, and services. It also serves as a platform for free mobility of students, academic and administrative staff, as well as for sharing infrastructures.

Regarding the current key global calls, the cooperation in the field of science and education within the 4EU+ Alliance is focused on 4 multi-disciplinary **Flagships**:

- 1. Health and Demographic Change in an Urban Environment;
- 2. Europe in a Changing World: Understanding and Engaging of Societies, Economies, Cultures and Languages;
- 3. Transformation of Science and Society by advancing Information, Computation and Communication;
- 4. Biodiversity and Sustainable Development.
