
Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP)

Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) is a new format within the Erasmus+ framework which **combines physical mobility** (5-30 days) and **virtual activities**. The BIP includes short teaching / study programmes or training, jointly developed and implemented by at least **3 higher education institutions from 3 different Erasmus+ programme countries**. Each programme focuses on a specific topic and has its own specific conditions.

Who can participate?

The programmes are open to students of all levels of study, depending on the conditions of the specific programme.

If you are interested in participating in a BIP programme, you must go through a selection procedure at the Faculty of Humanities.
