Priorities:

1. Implementation of the closest possible synergy between SIS and studies, especially .exe applications, revision of the API, especially between the file service and SIS, gradual implementation of various SIS 5 modules and active participation in their development/testing (especially the Online Course Registration module). Reworking of the scholarship app to comply with Financial Control requirements. Consistent elimination of rewriting between two databases or duplication of the same work in two databases (work with payments from SIS and JASU).

2. Return to the full-time admission procedure for all Czech master's programmes, adjustments to the admission procedure in connection with the increase in the number of applicants as a result of demographic developments (peak in 2026).

3. Reduction of the "precariat" in study administration, gradual creation of a smaller number of better-paid, full-time jobs. Overall revision of the form of study administration in connection with the evaluation of the Organisational Reform.

4. Revision of the Rules for the Organisation of Studies, reduction of the administrative burden, especially for bachelor's studies, and other measures that leading to an increase in the graduation rate and further optimisation in view of changes in the Principles of Financing.

5. Revision of the Rules for the Granting of Scholarships (in cooperation with the Student Chamber of the Academic Senate).
