## **Timothy Morton at FHS**

He beamed in, he spoke, he won (our brains and hearts). On November 1, one of the most influential philosophers of today, <u>Timothy Morton</u>, made their first appearance in the Czech Republic and gave us an online talk co-organized and shared by the Faculty of Humanities, <u>the Inspiration Forum</u> of <u>the Ji.hlava International Documentary Film Festival</u> and the ArtMap publishing house.
