Restaurants and bars

Kolkovna Celnice (V Celnici 1031/4) –it is one of the best restaurants in the city for typical Czech meal **Coloseum** (Ovocný trh 8, Václavské náměstí 1, Na Poříčí 1042/16, Legerova 64, Nádražní 25) – chain of very good italian resutaurants with many locations around the city

L'Osteria (Budova DRN Národní 135/14) – another very good italian restaurants with the biggest pizza in city

Maritrea (Týnská ulička – not ulice – 6) – upmarket vegetarian restaurant with veggie versions of some Czech classics

Café Montmartre (Řetězová 7) – café in the city centre, where you can get very cheap beer or wine, Kafka used to go to this café

Manifesto Market (Na Florenci, náměstí 14. října 82/16) – outdoor market, where you can get all types of food and only pay by card, there are now two of them in Prague

Where to go for a beer

Pilsnerka Národní (Národní 1987/22) – beer place in the city centre where you can get a litre of a beer **Lokál Dlouhááá** (Dlouhá 33) – favourite pub for foreigners and locals alike

Dva Kohouti (Sokolovská 81/55) – brewery with amazing beers like APA or IPA where you can sit on its garden, next to that is a place called Bufet, where you can get some "beer food"

U Fleků (V Celnici 1031/4) – Very old czech brewery, which is brewing their own black beer in very special place with medieval atmosphere

Skautský institut (Staroměstské nám. ½) – beer place belonging to czech scouts, where you can both study and drink super cheap beer on Old Town square

Týnská literární kavárna (Týnská 6) – hidden gem, literary café

Cafedu (Škrétova 490/12) – good place to study or just for a coffee, on Venceslas Square

Kavárna v sedmém nebi (Zborovská 68) – artistic café with lovely beer

Kavárna Velryba (Opatovická 24) – friendly café with a space called gallery at the back, which can accommodate bigger groups of people

Café Jericho (Opatovická 26) – chill student café/pub

mamacoffee (Vodičkova 6, Londýnská 49, Náměstí Jiřího z Poděbrad 12, Jaromírova 576) – artisan café with the best carrot cake in town (and vegetarian meals) – usually quite busy

Café Neustadt (Karlovo náměstí 1) – hipster vibes and good coffee (and sometimes great events and concerts as well)

Crème de la Crème (Národní 23) – place with the best ice cream in Prague

VNITROBLOCK – hipster place with restaurant, café and stores, sometimes there are some exhibitions

Café Letka (Letohradská 44) – very cosy café with breakfast offer and some desserts

Cukrárna Alchymista (Jana Zajíce 975/7) – café with the nicest little garden ever

Farm Letná (Korunovační 923/17) – insta-friendly place with very tasty meals

La Bohème Café (Sázavská 2031/32) – café with alternative ways of coffee preparation with very nice interior full of books, very suitable for studying
