GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ACCOMMODATION

- A deposit of 1,800 CZK plus the rent for the first full month to be paid before arrival. The deposit forms funds for payment of the last month of your accommodation. This advanced payment is not required for shortterm accommodation.
- The subsequent monthly payments must be made until the 20th of the preceding month.
- If a student wishes to leave the dorm earlier than is stated in the accommodation agreement, they need to inform the Accommodation Office on the first day of the preceding month at the latest in order to avoid penalisation. If not, there is a penalty of paying 25 days extra.


