Academic Calendar	The academic year is organised in two semesters. Each semester consists of a teaching period followed by an examination period. Winter Semester : mid-September to mid-February
	Summer Semester: mid-February to end of June
Orientation Week	Before the beginning of each semester, all new exchange students are expected to attend the FHS Orientation Week.
Subject Area	Humanities Even though the course offer may vary each academic year, a reasonable number of courses in the field of broad Humanities and Social Sciences is provided every semester.

Course Selection Learning Agreement	Students can select courses across all departments within the FHS as well as across BA and MA study programmes, unless there are specific entry requirements for the respective courses. Students may also choose courses that are offered by other CU faculties, but these must not comprise more than 49 % of all courses. All nominees will receive guidelines on designing their Learning Agreement via email.
Language of Instruction	English (some courses are also held in German and French) Students must have a sufficient knowledge of English (B2 according to CEFR). No language certificate is required. We may additionally ask for a proof of student's language proficiency, should we have any doubts regarding his/her level of English.
ECTS and Grading	We use ECTS credit system and students' performance is graded on 4 point grading scale (1, 2, 3, 4), with "3" as the minimum passing grade. Transcripts of Records indicates both the FHS grade and the corresponding ECTS grade.
