## **Financial Support at CU**

As an international full degree student, you are eligible for the scholarships mentioned below. These scholarships are intended to support international mobility and cover some of the financial costs of study-abroad stays.

- · Mobility Fund mostly for longer study stays (e.g. through bilateral university agreements)
- POINT short stays (e.g. summer schools)

Please note that eligibility for each scholarship is subject to different conditions. If you are going on Erasmus, you are not eligible for any additional scholarships apart from the original Erasmus scholarship awarded to you.

## **Mobility Fund**

What type of mobility is supported?

The objective of MF CU for students is to provide financial support, particularly for:

- studies at a university abroad for a period of one to two semesters (based on inter-university agreements; or as "free movers" for MA and PhD students; or within joint doctoral programs and cotutelle)
- short-term scientific or research stays abroad (trips to conferences, seminars, congresses, etc. are not supported); these stays are intended mainly for students of PhD study programmes for the purpose of research work. The minimum duration of the mobility is three weeks, however, mobilities with a longer duration (30 days +) are more likely to be supported by the CU Mobility Fund Committee.

FM CU's Priorities are announced annually. The full text of the Priorities for 2024 is available <a href="here">here</a> . Who can apply?

Support from MF CU funds can be provided to:

- · students in full-time study
  - When assessing applications for a financial contribution, the previous length of the study period will also be taken into account; applicants should be in the **standard period of study**.
- students who fulfill their study plan in timely manner (not lacking behind compulsory courses, recommended number
  of ECTS etc.)

When submitting an application and implementing mobility, it is necessary to follow the detailed Methodological guidelines and other important documents of FM CU, which can be found on the rectorace website of FM UK. Call for Applications 2025the selection procedure is held twice a year

In the spring round, it is possible to apply from February 1st to March 18 (3:00 p.m.) - the faculty deadline.

The application together with the mandatory attachments is to be submitted online via <u>portal "IS Věda"</u> (after login, go to "Enter the Internal Tenders"). The list of required attachments for individual categories of stay is provided in the application.

For all persons listed in the form, you must have their GDPR consent to ensure that they are aware of the use of their personal data (GDPR) as a part of the proposal.

The autumn round is usually held from 15. September till mid-October. Exact dates will be specified later.

## POINT

The POINT programme (Support for Internationalization of Charles University) is **one of the supporting tools of financing activities aimed to increase the level of internationalisation** at Charles University.

Supported student mobility activities

- Support for participation in or stays of Charles University students at summer schools (with the exception of language courses);
- Short-term unpaid student internships up to a maximum of 3 weeks.
- · Participation in International competitions and championships,
- Active Participation in Student conferences

• Attending meetings related to the internationalisation of Charles University activities.

Limitations and important info for student activities

- Summer language schools cannot be supported by POINT
- · It is not possible to apply for financial support from POINT and Mobility Fund for the same activity.
- Refunds are not possible. You can only apply for activities that will be held in future.
- One applicant can submit only one application for financial support in a given round.
- Financial Support from the POINT programme cannot be combined with financial support from the CU Grant Agency.
- Mobilities with **active** participation will be supported. By active participation we refer to active output or involvement in the program.
- Financial support can be awarded for accommodation, travel expenses and meals allowance. It is not possible to apply for a contribution to the participation fee.
- The maximum amount of allocated support is CZK 25,000.
- Support is preferentially provided to those applicants who have not yet received support from the POINT program before.
- The support is provided purposefully, i.e. it is linked to the specific applicant, activity and dates of implementation. Financial support cannot be requisitioned.

POINT programme is governed by the Rector's Measure no. 26/2024 .

Call for Applications 2025the selection procedure is held twice a year

- In the summer semester you can submit your applications from 1 April to 30 April, 16:00.
- In the winter semester, you can submit your applications from November 1 to November 30, 16.00.
